

Testing and Quarantine Requirements for Travelers to Myanmar by relief flight (1-8-2022)

1. Travelers who can't present the vaccination certificate and a negative COVID-19 RT-PCR test result issued at most 48 hours or travelers who have the complete vaccination certificate but do not have a negative COVID-19 RDT test result issued at most 48 hours before arrival may enter Myanmar only by relief flights.
2. Foreigners will not be allowed to take relief flight to Myanmar
3. Travelers must submit health declaration card to Health officials present at the airport upon arrival to Myanmar.
4. Thermal screening would be carried out in respect of all the passengers by the health officials present at the airport.
5. The travelers found to be symptomatic during screening shall be immediately isolated and taken to medical facility as per health protocol.
6. All travelers will be tested for COVID-19 by RDT on Day 1 and RT-PCR on Day 5 during their 7 days quarantine period.
7. Travelers who tested positive for COVID-19 shall be immediately isolated and taken to a medical facility/treatment center/hotel as per health protocol. Myanmar nationals shall bear the medical cost and other costs related to isolation and treatment in designated private hospital and hotel.
