**RESTRICTION OF SMOKING IN TRANSPORT CATEGORY (PASSENGER)
AIRCRAFT**

In order to comply with ICAO Assembly Resolution A29-15 and Action Item 33/4 of the 33rd Conference of Director General of Civil Aviation Asia and Pacific Regions, it will be necessary for all passenger transport aircraft on the Myanmar Register or flying internally in Myanmar under Myanmar Air Operator Certificate, to comply with the following _

1. It must be exhibited the notices stating smoking is prohibited in prominent places in the aircraft.
2. “**NO SMOKING**” sign must be always “**ON**” when the aircraft in operation.
3. No person shall smoke in any passenger aircraft in Myanmar. Certificate of Airworthiness will not be issued or renewed, if the above requirements have not been incorporated in the aircraft concerned.
